Dr. Rosenbaum is a Developmental Pediatrician, health services researcher, author, editor, lecturer, and mentor with a career-long interest in the challenges – for children and their families – of neurodisability. He is the author of 450 peer-reviewed papers and book chapters and author or editor of five books in the field. His current focus is on child and family wellbeing in the context of ‘disability’, with particular interest in whether and how we can prevent much of the physical and mental health morbidity to which parents and families of children with disabilities are known to be at risk.
